



Important Parish News regarding Fr Paul:

Below is information cut and pasted from a recent parish bulletin by Fr Paul:

It is coming up seven and a half years now that I have been enjoying the privilege and experience of sharing in the joy of the Gospel with you here at Chatswood, in our large, multi-cultural, vibrant, welcoming and faith filled community. I have made many good friends here and received so much support, personally and in sharing in the ministry collaboratively with you all as parish team, volunteer ministers and as a faithful, prayerful community sharing in worship, growing in faith and outreach. Over the last 12 months we have grown with many experiencing and still continuing to experience a deeper relationship with Jesus and the Holy Spirit through ALPHA, joining in service through a ministry and supporting the parish to grow financially.

Recently Bishop Peter Comensoli has discussed with me the possibility of a move to leadership in another parish. Chatswood being the biggest and one of the most actively engaged parishes in many ways, requires good ongoing leadership that can be sustained over a reasonable time frame. Bishop Peter believes that seven and a half years is a good time to hand over to new leadership. I have accepted Bishop Peter's request to move to a new parish. The move is not until 12 January 2018, so still a good three months away. I will be moving to Kincumber on the Central Coast. I am pleased to announce that Bishop Peter's replacement for me is one of our youngest, most vibrant, actively engaged, missionary and faith filled priests, full of energy, joy, warmth and very friendly. I am talking about Fr. Jim McKeon who is presently at Kincumber. Please make him welcome in due course. We already have a friendship with Holy Cross parish Kincumber as we have helped their financial burden in helping them to pay for their Church through the St Peter and St Paul Fund. You can see a photo of the Church in the foyer given to us in thanksgiving for this help.

In the meantime let us continue together to build God's Kingdom of love here, to grow in faith, and worship our loving Lord, so Fr. Jim will have a welcoming and faith filled parish to belong to. It is "Name Tag Sunday" today so let us call each other by name.
