Dear Parents and Friends,

Last weekend's gospel had a very important warning for all of us to tune-in to.

I sense you might appreciate the following story that packs a powerful message

Hachiko might be the most faithful dog in the world. Every day he was on hand to see his owner go off to work. Every afternoon at 4pm when the train pulled into Japan's Shibuya Station, Hachiko was there to greet his owner. After some pats and a warm hug, they would walk home together. One day, Hachiko's owner didn't get off the train. He had died at work and never returned. But Hachiko still waited in fervent hope. The next day at 4pm, the dog returned to the train station to await his master's return.

For the next ten years, Hachiko never gave up hope. He continued to live with his owner's family and went to the train station every day. When Hachiko died the local townspeople erected a bronze statue of him and put it at the spot where he always waited.

Since the beginning, the early prophets foretold the coming of a messiah. Just like Hachiko, we still wait for the return of Jesus.

Last weekend's Gospel calls us to be vigilant and faithful, like Hachiko. We are warned: "Stay awake."

Important notes:

2. Bring a chair to sit on – and a picnic rug. You may bring low level chairs, beanbags or inflatables for your comfort, tall back or high chairs will need to go towards the back to ensure everyone can see.
3. Bring a picnic dinner and/or have a sausage sizzle!
4. **No alcohol is to be brought to this function** - (This is a Catholic Schools Office requirement - for events like our ‘Starry Starry Night Carols Evening’)

Several important safety matters (WHS matters) regarding the evening:

- ◆ Parents are responsible for total supervision of their children for the total duration of the event (NB: PARENTS MUST NOT DROP THEIR CHILD/REN OFF AND LEAVE)
- ◆ No alcohol is permitted at the event
- ◆ All families must leave the school site after the outdoor movie screening (approx. 9pm)
- ◆ The play equipment is out of bounds all evening
- ◆ Students are not permitted to play any running games
- ◆ Parents are reminded about hot beverages etc and safety - (students do not need to have any hot beverages)
- ◆ No vehicles will be permitted on the school grounds during the evening
- ◆ No smoking is permitted on the school grounds
- ◆ Classrooms, hall, library etc are all out of bounds
- ◆ Evacuation routes will be clear (NB Kirk St double gates open at all times and Archer St exit area open at all times too)

Orientation to new classes

Infants Road Safety days (Week 10)

Following on from the Road Safety play the children watched at Mercy College last week, all the children in Kindergarten, Year 1 and Year 2 will be involved in a bike/scooter safety lesson at school. We will be inviting the students to bring in their bikes and scooters to school (helmets are compulsory). If your child does not have a bike or scooter or is unable to ride one, it is ok, we can either share or give them other fun jobs during the day.

During the lesson students will learn about road signs, how to cross at zebra crossing and lights and how to ride safely on footpaths. They will also complete a fun obstacle course. The sessions will involve practical lessons in the playground and theoretical lessons in the classroom.

When students arrive at school, all bikes and scooters will be 'parked' in a special OLD parking area in the playground (valet parking will be unavailable). 😊

Students wear sports uniform on their bike/scooter safety day.

Wednesday 13th December: Year 1 (9-10.30; 1B 11.20-12.30; 1G)

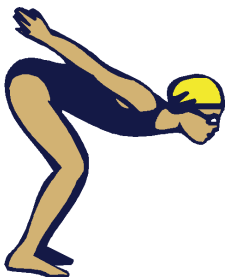
Children's Liturgy of the Word

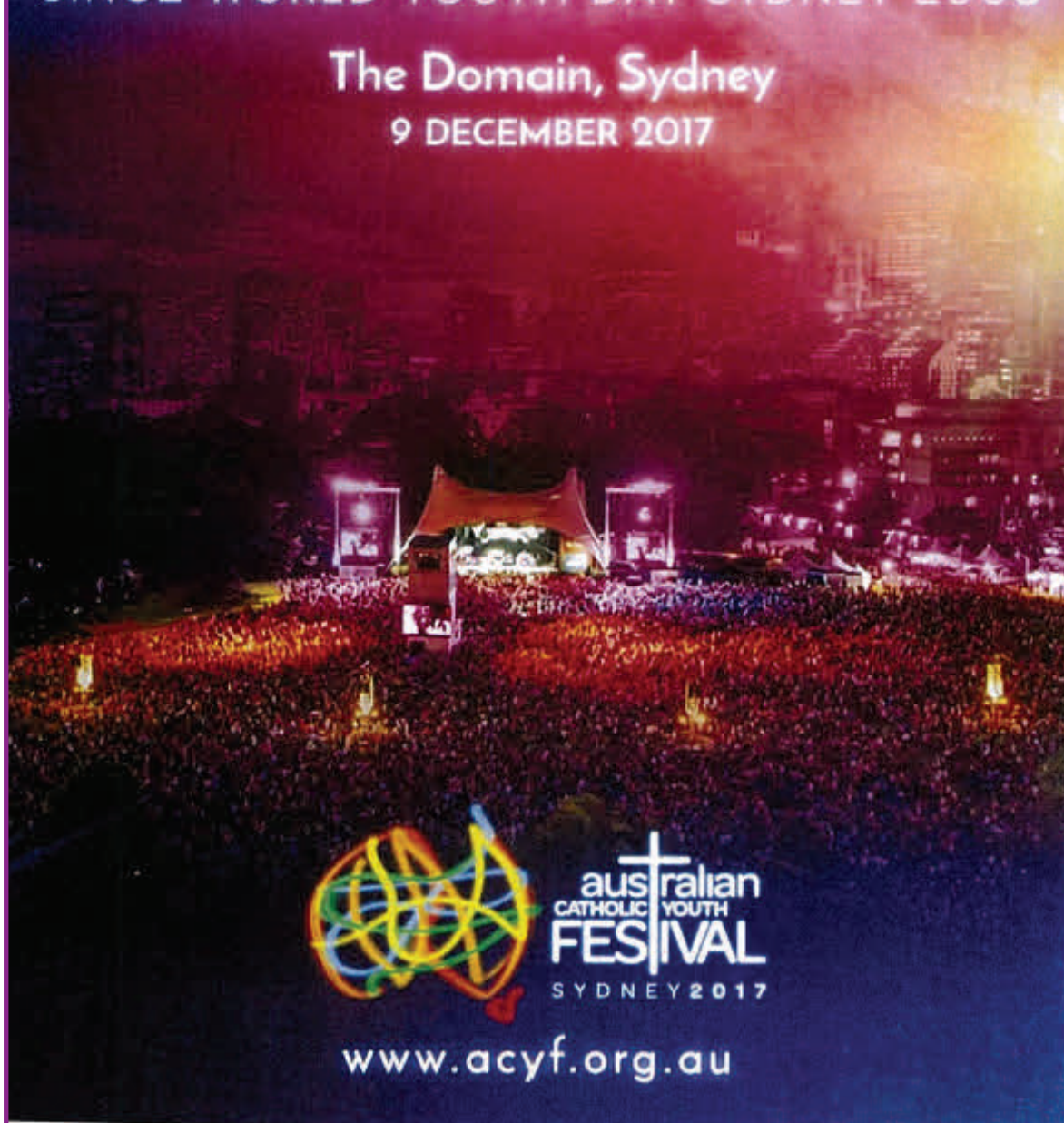
