Eyes ahead!

The Church year is drawing to a close. It will soon be Advent, then Christmas ... At this time of year the Church's readings remind us that the earth as we know it is passing away and that Christ will come again at the end of time. What does this mean for our lives? It means we are to live each day with a sense of hope, expectation, vigilance and ready to meet the Lord at all times. Pope Francis says, "It means not allowing ourselves to be overwhelmed by distraction or by superficiality, but living in a full and aware way, with concern first of all for others".

Last year, I made a big fuss about the agapanthus plants that are just getting ready to flower. Indeed this purple flower (sometimes called "The Star of Bethlehem") is a special reminder to keep our 'eyes ahead', to 'get ready' and to live primarily with a 'concern for others'.

Readers can rest assured that I will get the special "Star of Bethlehem" sign out the front of the office again this year ... I confess that I am yet to see the flower stems outside the office yet ... Have others seen anything?

OLD School is growing in student numbers, and we need another class/teacher at OLD in 2019.

Class structures at OLD for 2019:

As per discussion at the recent P+F AGM, classes at OLD 2019 will be structured as follows:

Kindergartenx 2 classesYear 1x 2 classesYear 2x 2 classesYear 3x 2 classesYear 4x 2 classes

Year 5 x 2 classes (NB there is a special condition with one of the 2019 Y5 classes; CSO will only support funding one of the Y5 classes for Term 1 at this early stage ... Provided the numbers stay strong, like they presently are, this 'special class' will be funded for all of $\underline{2019}$)

Year 6 x 1 class

Over the coming weeks, teachers will be carefully and strategically ensuring classes K-5 are divided evenly and fairly to ensure the best possible outcomes for students' social, emotional and academic development. I respectfully ask parents not to request teachers for their children and not to request placement with specific students in a specific class. I cannot stress to parents more strongly that the collective wisdom of the school staff is what best divides the classes in the fairest and best way possible. Even moving just one child from one class to another can upset the balance.

This considered, if there are extremely serious circumstances the school needs to be aware of, I ask you to discuss this with me over the coming week. Thank you.

On Monday 17 December in the afternoon, students will have 'Orientation to classes for 2019'. In this session, students will meet their classroom teacher for 2019.

Eligibility for Fee Discounts

- The first child is the child in the family who is in the most senior class of any systemics chool in the Diocese of Broken Bay (some exceptions do apply, see below). Second and subsequent children are defined in descending order of class seniority of children attending any systemic Catholic School in the Diocese of Broken Bay.
- The following schools are also included as "systemic" for the purposes of Tuition Fee discounting only (not applicable to family Building Levy):
 - · St Edwards, East Gosford
 - Stella Maris, Manly
- Rates currently applicable are as follows:

◆ Second child 20% discount
 ◆ Third child 50% discount
 ◆ Fourth & subsequent children 100% discount

- Students attending systemic schools in the Archdiocese of Sydney, Diocese of Parramatta and the Diocese of Wollongong may also be eligible for sibling discounts on Tuition Fees (as above), and a reduction on the Diocese of Broken Bay Building Levy. Please ensure these students are listed on the first page of this form.
- Parents/caregivers must notify the school of any changes to the enrolments listed on this form. In this event, a
 new form must be completed and submitted to the school/college and any discounts will be adjusted
 accordingly.

Terms & Conditions relating to payment of School Fees

- Tuition Fees and Building Levy are set each year by the Diocesan Schools Board.
- School fees will be billed and invoiced on an annual basis. The standard payment terms are in three
 instalments in February, April and July.
- The dates for payment will be clearly identified on the invoice issued at the beginning of the school year.
- Sibling Discounts on Tuition Fees are not automatic-application must be made by completing, signing and submitting this form by the due date.
- Fees are payable by BPay, EFTPOS, Cheque or Credit Card (Visa, MasterCard only).
- Families may make arrangements to alter the Standard payment terms. Payments may be altered to be made either yearly, monthly, fortnightly or weekly. Please indicate under Terms of Payment overleaf.
- If both parents/caregivers signed the original enrolment form, then both parents/caregivers are responsible for payment of the fees unless Split Billing Forms have been completed and submitted to the school.
- In cases of genuine financial hardship, families may be eligible for a fee concession. Please contact the School Fee Liaison Unit on 9847 0728 or schoolfees@dbb.org.au for further information.




