### Principal's piece cont.

Two newly installed murals at Our Lady of Dolours School will most certainly ignite a remarkable sense of joy and excitement in the imaginative hearts and minds of the students. Over the April school holidays, mural artists have been hard at work transforming the bare brick walls that enclose the school's playground.

Through a grant from the NSW Government's Community Building Partnership Program, and championed by a creative group of parents, the school set out to reinvigorate the playground. With a vision to enhance the sense of community, encourage pride of place and celebrate cultural diversity, a mural competition was held. An inundation of entries from students, emerging and established artists, meant the school community and students had a tough decision voting for the final artworks.

PLC alumni Sohpi Odling, whose work has been included in the Willoughby Visual Arts Biennial 2017 and the Bondi Beach Graffiti Wall, has created something she hopes will inspire students. "My works are emotional celebrations through colour and detail, whilst at the same time make cultural statements on how a variety of beauty can be perceived and celebrated."

Former Blue Mountains now innerwest duo, Scott Nagy and Krimsone (aka Janne Birkner) blend graffiti with fine art, crafting surreal scenes heavily influenced by flora and fauna. Having done several murals in schools and public places, their work is designed to and the principal says



become part of the community.

For Our Lady of Dolours, they say "We wanted to give the kids a look into a colourful world that flourishes in imagination. It's a celebration of life, that gives the viewer a break from reality and sparks the mind with ideas, wonder and joy." And spark the mind it does, with one student, lack aged 7, stating "I want to climb into the treehouse!". Of the murals, lasmine, aged 9, has said, "It's amazing to have colour in the playground". Principal, Philip Ledlin is looking forward to the start of term two, "The parents and staff are so excited to see the students' faces on the first day back!"
