Parent Information Session: The MAI assessment: **Monday 2nd December; 6-7pm**, I will be holding an information session to explain the MAI assessment. The MAI (Mathematical Assessment Instrument) is a one-on-one assessment that ALL children will participate in on the first day of the 2020 school year (as they have done so for the past 7 years). During this session I will be explain the purpose of this assessment; what kind of data it provides teachers and the school; what the assessment is teaching us about your children; how teachers use the data and I will be showing some examples of the questions. This is a very important assessment as it does not inform us of how fast your child can recite Mathematical facts, such as their times tables, but what strategies they use to problem solve. SUPPORTING FAMILIES IN DROUGHT (Friday 13th December - Gold coin donation day)

Wee Waa has had suffered drought for over six years. Unfortunately, due to lack of water and failing farms, many of the school families are no longer able to afford to buy fresh food for their children. The Principal Mr Alistair Stewart is trying to support his school community by providing the children food through the school tuck shop. Any food not used is made into food parcels and frozen and distributed discreetly to needy families in and around the town. If you can help, please make a gold coin or 'fiver for a farmer' donation on our '**Christmas Gold coin day' (13th December)** to help St Joseph's buy more food and prepare food parcels. The food is being purchased from local shops which will also help the town.

Message from the 2019 P&F executive committee

Dear O.L.D. Parents,

Since the introduction of the P&F Levy to O.L.D. at the beginning of 2019 the role of the P&F has changed quite significantly and continues to evolve.

With immediate effect, the P&F Meeting will be replaced with a Town Hall which will be an open forum for the Principal to provide parents with a quarterly update and also an opportunity for all parents to ask questions or raise topics for discussion. Discussion will also take place during the Town Hall on what the annual P&F Levy will be spent on. <u>The first Town Hall meeting will take place on Monday, 25 November</u> **2019, 6.30pm in the school library (this will replace the AGM)**. The meeting will also be streamed live on Facebook. Eligibility for Fee Discounts

- The first child is the child in the family who is in the most senior class of any systemic school in the Diocese of Broken Bay (some exceptions do apply, see below). Second and subsequent children are defined in descending order of class seniority of children attending any systemic Catholic School in the Diocese of Broken Bay or any other school in NSW.
- The following schools are also included as "systemic" for the purposes of Tuition Fee discounting only (not applicable to family Building Levy):
 - St Edward's, East Gosford
 - Stella Maris, Manly
 - St Lucy's, Wahroonga
 - St Edmund's, Wahroonga
- Rates currently applicable are as follows:

٠	Second child	20% discount
٠	Third child	50% discount

- Fourth & subsequent children
 100% discount
- Students attending systemic schools in the Archdiocese of Sydney, Diocese of Parramatta and the Diocese of Wollongong may also be eligible for sibling discounts on Tuition Fees (as above), and a reduction on the Diocese of Broken Bay Building Levy. Please ensure these students are listed on the first page of this form.
- Parents/caregivers must notify the school of any changes to the enrolments listed on this form. In this event, a
 new form must be completed and submitted to the school/college and any discounts will be adjusted
 accordingly.

Terms & Conditions relating to payment of School Fees

- 1. Tuition Fees and Building Levy are set each year by the Diocesan Schools Board.
- School fees will be billed and invoiced on an annual basis. The standard payment terms are in three instalments in February, April and July.
- The dates for payment will be clearly identified on the invoice issued at the beginning of the school year.
- Sibling Discounts on Tuition Fees are not automatic application must be made by completing, signing and submitting this form by the due date.
- 5. Fees are payable by BPay, EFTPOS, Cheque or Credit Card (Visa, MasterCard only).
- Families may make arrangements to alter the Standard payment terms. Payments may be altered to be made either yearly, monthly, fortnightly or weekly. Please indicate under Terms of Payment overleaf.
- If both parents/caregivers signed the original enrolment form, then both parents/caregivers are responsible for payment of the fees unless Split Billing Forms have been completed and submitted to the school.
- In cases of genuine financial hardship, families may be eligible for a fee concession. Please contact the School Fee Liaison Unit on 9847 0728 or <u>schoolfees@dbb.org.au</u> for further information.

- A Tax Invoice for 2020 will be emailed to you by the Catholic Schools Office in late January 2020. The total owing for the year will be split into instalments and the due date for the payment of each instalment specified on that invoice. Instalment options are annual, standard (3 payments), monthly or fortnightly.
- Our preferred method of payment for your school fees is BPAY. Payment can also be made by our Qkr! App or credit card (Mastercard or VISA). Credit card payments can be made in person at the School Office or by completing & sending the credit card slip at the bottom of your Fee Statement into the School Office.
- Tuition Fees and Diocesan Building Levies are determined by the Catholic Schools Office of the Broken Bay Diocese – not by the School. 100% of these fees and levies collected are sent to Catholic Schools Office.
- The School Education Fee covers curriculum resources, sports levies & general sports equipment, excursions
 and incursions including the Creative Arts Festival, school security, whole school & hall cleaning & maintenance of
 the garden & grounds.
- The Technology Levy is billed per family and covers classroom technology requirements.

2020 school travel applications now open



To assist with any enquiries you may receive regarding student travel applications, we have provided some information below.

Applications for student travel in 2020 opened on Friday, 11 October 2019.

Students progressing to year 3 and year 7 no longer need to re-apply if they:

- are continuing at the same school
- are residing at the same address

have not been sent an expiry notification from Transport for NSW.

Where a student meets the new distance eligibility, the system will automatically update their entitlement. If they do not meet the new eligibility, they will receive an expiry notification via email.

Students who have an entitlement approved under a medical condition which is due to expire will receive a notification advising them to re-apply.

Term Bus Pass holders will receive a notification to re-apply.

If students need to update their information or re-apply, they should go online to <u>https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/</u> updateDetails

Applications need to be submitted before 31 December 2019 to ensure student entitlements are updated and their current entitlement/card is not cancelled. If their application is submitted after 31 December 2019, the system will automatically cancel an entitlement/card and a new one will need to be issued.

Students in the Opal network applying for a SSTS or Term Bus Pass entitlement for the first time will receive their card at their nominated postal address. Cards will be mailed out from January 2020.
