SCHOOL SWIMMING CARNIVAL WEDNESDAY 9TH DECEMBER 2020 Week 9

Dear Parents and Carers,

Our School Swimming Carnival will be held on Wednesday 9th December at Ku-ring-gai Fitness and Aquatic Centre, West Pymble.

Due to COVID restrictions, participation in this carnival is only open for <u>children who turn 8, 9, 10, 11 or 12</u> in 2021 and are attending OLD in 2021. <u>Only 50m swimming races will be held</u>.

The carnival will be start at 10.00 a.m. The children will travel to and from the pool by bus. Please be aware, even though we are having our Swimming Carnival before the end of this year, <u>all ages are WHAT AGE YOUR</u> <u>CHILD TURNS DURING 2021</u>. Students not participating will remain at school.

Any Year 1 students who turn 8 in 2021 are invited to compete in 50m races.

PLEASE NOTE CAREFULLY

- Only 50m & 100m FREESTYLE, and 50m BACKSTROKE, BREASTSTROKE & BUTTERFLY RACES WILL BE HELD
- All races will be held in the outdoor 50m pools.
- 100m Freestyle races are for students who are VERY CAPABLE in racing this distance (including diving and turning)
- Your child MUST be able to swim, unaided, the length of the event you nominate them for.
- Your child MUST be able to swim the correct stroke for the event you nominate and be able to dive in from the blocks.
- <u>All 50m swimming races will be timed</u>. Times will be used for selection purposes for next year's Cluster Swimming Carnival.
- Only students who will turn 8, 9, 10, 11 or 12 in 2021 and attending O.L.D. in 2021 are eligible for Cluster selection early next year.

There will be NO changes made to the program on the day of the carnival. Please choose events carefully so as to avoid disappointment and confusion.



On Swimming Carnival day children must come to school before the 8.45 bell in their full <u>sports uniform</u>. <u>Swimming costumes are to be worn underneath their uniform</u> as there will be no time to change before the carnival. Children may change out of their swimming costume when finish their races or return to school. <u>ALL children are to wear their colour house swimming cap – children will not be permitted to enter</u> <u>the pool and swim without a cap</u>. Swimming caps may be purchased through QKR and picked up at the school office for \$5.00 each. Get in quick as the school office may run out of stock (NB: We are currently out of stock but more should arrive within a week).

Thongs or sandals may be brought to school to be changed into only when going to the pool. They are not to be worn to school. Children must wear a hat, bring a towel and sunscreen. They must also bring their morning tea, lunch and plenty of drinks (no glass bottles please!)

Students will not need money as they are not allowed to buy from the canteen while they are at the pool. Parents at the swimming carnival are asked to <u>refrain from buying</u> for their children as this is unfair on those who have no one to buy for them.

Due to COVID restrictions, NO PARENTS ARE PERMITTED TO ATTEND AS SPECTATORS.

A minimum number of parent helpers are required for timing of events. Please nominate yourself to assist on the permission form.

> Parents must ensure that they are not unwell when they attend as a helper. Masks are required for all parent helpers.

Please complete the attached form and <u>return it to your child's class teacher</u> BY <u>WEDNESDAY 18[™] NOVEMBER</u>. It is essential that the forms are returned by this date to enable the program to be organised.

PLEASE NOTE: Parents are not permitted to take their child/ren home at the end fo the carnival. All children will return to school at the conclusion of the carnival as this is a full school day.

School Travel for 2021



2021 school travel applications are now open

Applications for student travel in 2021 opened from Monday 12 October 2020.

Students who require a School Opal card or travel pass for 2021 can now <u>apply</u> online. A new application should be submitted if a student is applying for a school travel pass for the first time or requesting an additional pass as a result of a new shared parental responsibility situation (e.g. joint custody).

Students who have changed school/campus, changed address, repeated a year or received an expiry notification from Transport for NSW for their school travel entitlement should <u>re-apply or update their details</u>.

*Applications must be completed by the student's parent or legal guardian if the student is aged under 16 years. Students 16 years and over must complete the application form themselves.

Where there is a change of distance eligibility based on a student's grade, the system will automatically update a student's entitlement if they meet the new criteria. If they do not meet the new <u>eligibility criteria</u>, they will receive an expiry notification via email.

Students who have an entitlement approved under a medical condition which is due to expire will receive a notification advising them to re-apply.

Term Bus Pass holders will receive a notification to re-apply.

If a student needs to update their information or re-apply, they should go online to https://apps.transport.nsw.gov.au/ssts/updateDetails

Applications need to be submitted before 31 December 2020 to ensure that current student entitlements are updated and their current entitlement/card remains valid. If their application is submitted after 31 December 2020, the system will automatically cancel an entitlement/card and a new one will need to be issued.

Students in the Opal network applying for a SSTS or Term Bus Pass entitlement for the first time will receive their card at their nominated postal address. Cards will be mailed out from January 2021. Students residing in Rural and Regional (R&R) areas should receive their travel pass at the commencement of the new school year from their nominated operator, this may be distributed via the school or sent direct to their address. Note: some R&R operators do not issue travel passes. Students/Parents should confirm with their nominated operator if they do not receive a pass.

New Concession Entitlement Cards

Transport for NSW will be replacing the below cards with Transport Concession Entitlement Cards (TCEC) from October 2020:

- Senior Secondary Student Concession Card (16 years and over) also used by Mature Secondary Students (18 years and over), Distance Education Students and Home School Students
- Proof of Age card (when a student under 16 years of age looks older)
- Boarder Rail Pass.

All previous cards will be valid until they expire. Students who require a Transport Concession Entitlement Card should speak with their school administration staff.
