

COMPASS

Every parent must enter their child's absence before 9am. If your child is marked 'not present' by the teacher and you have not entered an absence note you will be sent a notification informing you that your child is not at school. You will need to add the absence as soon as possible. You will also receive an email to remind you to enter the absence reason within 7 days. Remember, every school day is important for your child's social, emotional and academic development.

<u>Permission notes and Internet agreements</u>

Parents are reminded to return internet agreements and all other permission notes to their child's classroom teacher as soon as possible.

Communicating with teachers

A reminder that all parents must email <u>teachers via the school</u> email (old@dbb.catholic.edu.au) which gets forwarded to each teacher. A teacher is unable to reply to emails or phone calls during school time, as their main priority is the education of your children and every teacher has a duty of care for their students. If a message is urgent please call the school office for the message to be communicated to the teacher as soon as possible.

Dropping forgotten items at school

In a bid to encourage independence in our students we would ask that you do not drop forgotten items at school unless it is an emergency. Getting items to students once the school day has started interrupts valuable learning time for the student. Instead we encourage you to assist your child/ren to develop a routine in packing their school bags the night before—you will quickly be amazed by how independent and responsible your child becomes.

DOUBLE PARKING

Do not double park at any time. Double parking is illegal and dangerous especially around schools. It reduces



U TURNS

- Performing U turns or 3 point turns in school zones is extremely dangerous.
- Performing U turns across unbroken centre lines is fliegal and is particularly dangerous around schools



PARKING / STOPPING NEAR INTERSECTIONS

It is lilegal to park or stop less than 10 metres from an intersection with no traffic lights as this blocks visibility for turning drivers and creates a hazard for all motorists.



PEDESTRIAN CROSSINGS AND CHILDREN'S CROSSINGS

- Slow down as you approach pede crossings and children's crossings
- Do not proceed if the road beyond the crossing is blocked.
- Do not stop or park in the No Sto zones on either side of the crossi this blocks visibility.
- At a children's crossing you must stop at or before the stop line if there is a pedestrian about to cross or alrea

HOLDING HANDS IN TRAFFIC

- All children need to be actively supervised in and around moving vehicles, tootpaths, shared paths, driveways, car parks, at traffic lights, pedestrian crossings, on quiet streets and busy roads.
- Make sure you always set a good example around to and talk to your children about why you are stoppin at the kerb and what you are watching and listening Explain where and when it is safe to cross and why.

Road Rule Reminders









NO STOPPING ZONES

No Stopping signs mean you must not stop here at any time. If times of operation are shown on the sign, the restriction applies only at those times.

An unbroken yellowkerb line is a no stopping line. You must not stop for any

BUS ZONE SIGNS

operation are shown on the sign, the restriction applies only at those times.

You must not park your vehicle less than 20 metres before or 10 metres after a bus





NO PARKING SIGNS

You can only step in a No Parking zone while picking up or setting down passengers or goods. You have a maximum of 2 minutes from the time you stop and must stay within 3 metres of your vehicle at all times.

If times of operation are shown on the sign, the restriction applies only at those times. This is not a waiting zone.



- Driveways are not playgrounds. Be aware that children can go unnefficed in front and behind your vehicle. Do not solely rely on reverse sensors or cameras in your
- Adways supervise and hold a child's hand near/crossing driveways. It is tilegal to park in or across any driveway or to block a footpath at any time.

TIME RESTRICTED PARKING

Parking signs with specified time limits allow drivers to park their vehicle for a maximum period of time, e.g. 5 minutes, 1 hour etc.

If times of operation are shown on the sign the restriction applies only at those times.

USING MOBILE PHONES

- driving unless your phone is secured in a fixed mounting or does not require you to touch or manipulate the phone in any way.
- . It is illegal to use the other features of a mobile phone such as texting, emailing etc unless your car is legally parked and the ignition is switched off.
- Using mobile phones is a major distraction for drivers and incurs higher fines and dement points in school zones.
