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Holy Week

This week OLD commemorated the significant events of Holy Week.

Kindergarten began our Holy Week with a beautiful Palm Sunday Liturgy. During this Liturgy we remembered that Jesus entered Jerusalem on a donkey, with crowds of people welcoming him with palms. They shouted 'Hosanna!' which means 'The Lord saves us!'

On Thursday afternoon, the whole school congregated for a reflective Holy Week Liturgy dramatisation. This included The Washing of the Feet (Year 1), The Last Supper (Year 2), The Garden of Gethsemane (Year 3), The Arrest of Jesus (Year 4) and The Stations of the Cross (Year 5/6). This Liturgy was a reflective and moving experience in which the children learnt about Jesus' love for us through his sacrifice.

On Palm Sunday, 2021, Pope Francis reminded us "Let us start over from amazement. Let us gaze upon Jesus on the cross and say to him: "Lord, how much you love me! How precious I am to you!" Let us be amazed by Jesus so that we can start living again, for the grandeur of life lies not in possessions and promotions, but in realizing that we are loved."




Fantastic results from our Year 6 basketball team the "Funky Bunch" who were runners up in the Grand Final of the first season of U13 basketball at Crows Nest.


