## <u>Safety at OLD regarding Nuts/Nut products & Egg/Egg products</u>

Several students at OLD have a serious, life threatening allergic reaction to Nuts/nut products, eggs/egg products. Because of this, we strenuously ask all families to not send nuts/nut products and egg/egg product to school in your children's lunches. Thank you for your anticipated support of this critical matter.

#### COVID

Thank you for your efforts in collecting Rapid Antigen Tests (RATs) for your child/ren. We will be notifying the community when the next allocation is ready to collect. A reminder that the tests are to be done on a Monday and Wednesday morning before school. The school only needs to be notified of a positive result, as is NSW Health. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding in regards to drop off and pick up procedures as we all navigate through the challenges COVID presents us with.

#### **Parent Reminders**

#### **COMPASS**

Every parent must enter their child's absence before 9am. If your child is marked 'not present' by the teacher and you have not entered an absence note you will be sent a notification informing you that your child is not at school. You will need to add the absence as soon as possible. You will also receive an email to remind you to enter the absence reason within 7 days. Remember, every school day is important for your child's social, emotional and academic development.

#### Communicating with teachers

A reminder that all parents must email teachers via the school email (old@dbb.catholic.edu.au) which gets forwarded to each teacher. A teacher is unable to reply to emails or phone calls during school time, as their main priority is the education of your children and every teacher has a duty of care for their students. If a message is urgent please call the school office for the message to be communicated to the teacher as soon as possible.

#### **Dropping forgotten items at school**

In a bid to encourage independence in our students we would ask that you do not drop forgotten items at school unless it is an emergency. Getting items to students once the school day has started interrupts valuable learning time for the student. Instead we encourage you to assist your child/ren to develop a routine in packing their school bags the night before—you will quickly be amazed by how independent and responsible your child becomes.

Set up your account

1. **Download the Flexischools App** Download the app from the App Store or from Google Play.

- 2. **Register** Open the Flexischools App and click 'Like to register?', enter your email address and click 'Register'. You will be sent a registration email. Follow the instructions in the registration email to finish setting up your account. Once your account is set up, login to the Flexischools App, select the Profile icon on the grey navigation bar, select Student and 'Add a student', search for their school name, select their year level and class and enter their details.
- 3. Top Up Your Account To make ordering fast and simple, you can set up automatic top ups.

- 2. Make your selection Select the items you wish to order.
