#### The Miraculous Medal


This week all children at Our Lady of Dolours received their own 'miraculous medal. This medal was specially blessed by a priest and dedicated for all people here at Our Lady of Dolours. The front of the miraculous medal shows Mother Mary. The back of the medal features an M, which stands for "Mary". The cross represents Jesus. The two hearts are for the immaculate heart of Mary and the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The 12 stars symbolise the 12 apostles.

Keeping the this medal near is you is a wonderful way to think of Mary, pray to Mary and be closer to her Son, Jesus.


