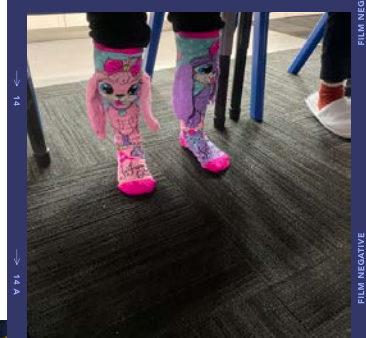
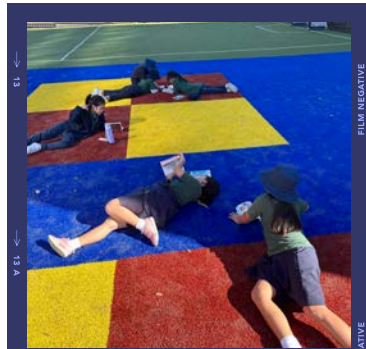
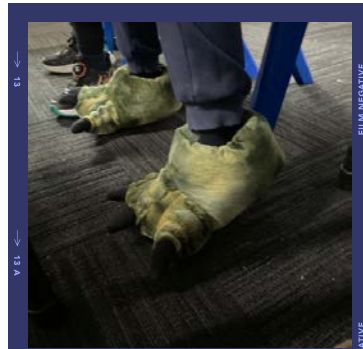
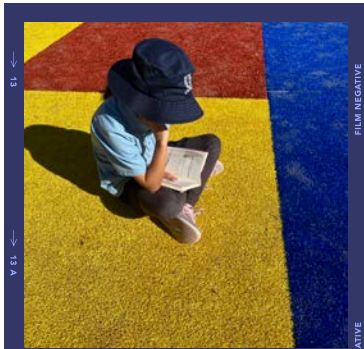
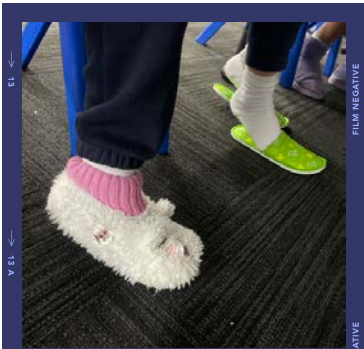
Year 3 having lots of fun with the Sphero's and exploring how they move



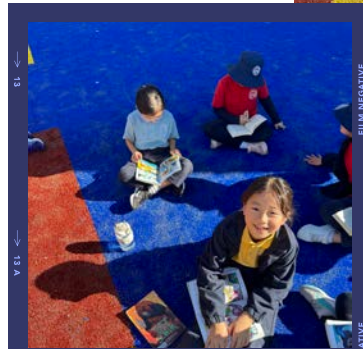
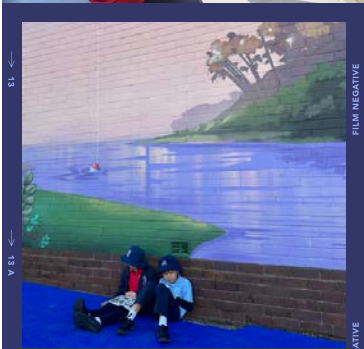
This week in STEM, 3G have been involved in a 'Ping Pong Pick Up' Challenge. The engineering challenge was to build a device that can pick up a ping pong ball from a distance and return it to a start line. They were able to use paper, sticky tape, string and paper clips. Students worked collaboratively using the 4 Cs – creativity, critical thinking, collaboration and communication to design and make their device. 3G then came together as a class to test the devices. There was great excitement in the 3G classroom when a device successfully picked up the ping pong ball and made it over the start line.

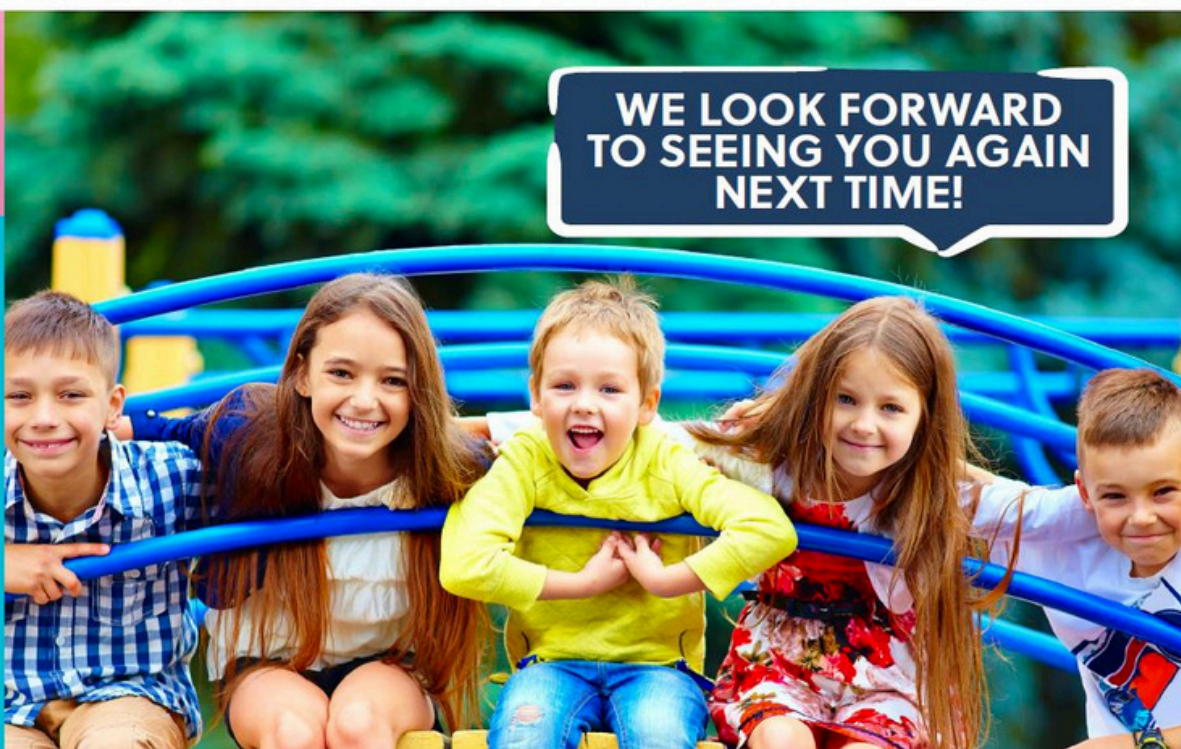
