National Reconciliation Week

Reconciliation Week:

From 27 May to 3 June, our school will observe National Reconciliation Week (NRW), a time for all Australians to learn about our shared histories and explore how each of us can contribute to achieving reconciliation in Australia. Reconciliation must live in the hearts, minds, and actions of all Australians as we strive to build respectful relationships between the wider Australian community and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.



The 2025 theme, "Bridging Now to Next," invites us to reflect on our shared history, acknowledge the present, and work together towards a united future. It emphasises the importance of learning from past experiences to guide us forward.

On the day following the Mass for the Inauguration of his Petrine Ministry, Pope Leo XIV also spoke about "dialogue and building bridges" in the hope of reconciliation and peace. Pope Leo echoed the message of Pope Francis and encouraged followers to continue Francis' mission to say yes to peace and reconciliation in our world.






